#### **Packet Pick-Up**

Pick up your race bib and shwag bag at these times and locations in NYC and Southampton during race week. *Please note the times as they've changed from last year* and that packets will not be available at JackRabbit or in Southampton outside of these times.

**Friday, September 27: 6 PM - 8:30PM**, Southampton Intermediate School, 70 Leland Lane, Southampton

Saturday, September 28: 6 AM - 7AM, Southampton Intermediate School, 70 Leland Lane, Southampton

You can have a friend pick up your packet for you with a copy of your ID (this can be a picture on your phone, or a printed copy of an ID). *Packets are not available outside of these times.* 

#### **Getting Here**

If you are still undecided about transportation to the race, there are still a few spots on the Hampton Jitney Jaunt that will take you directly from NYC or designated exits on the LIE to the race start. Arrive rested and ready. Buses will leave Manhattan at 5:00 AM and arrive at the starting line by 7:00 AM. Advance reservations are required for

If you are driving out east, please note that there is very little on street parking in Southampton Village but we have a few free and easy options for you. There is free parking available in the village parking lots with a Hampton Jitney shuttle to the start and back. We have worked with the local police and the three-hour parking limit in the village will not be enforced. There will be free parking at a field at Wickapogue Road and Olde Towne Road. This is a half mile from the race start and there will be a Hampton Jitney shuttle provided to the race start and back.

purchased a parking pass you will be receiving a hang-tag for your car at packet pick up. If you purchase a pass and aren't picking up till race morning, we will send you a separate email on Tuesday with proof of purchase so you can access the onsite lot. You can park at the high school, retrieve your bib and shwag and then put your hang tag in your car.

We offered limited on-site parking but these parking passes have sold out. If you
